## FOOD PLANT HIGH-FOAMING SOLVENT-DEGREASER

### TYPICAL APPLICATIONS

**EVER-KLEEN 9243** is recommended for the removal of grease, wax, and oily films on food processing equipment and structures. It can be used on soft metals and is effective on tile, rubber, and plastic surfaces.

#### **Concentrated**

**EVER-KLEEN 9243** has been formulated specifically for effective degreasing at low use-solution concentration. The result is a low-cost cleaner with optimum performance.

#### **Convenient**

**EVER-KLEEN 9243** is a liquid cleaner, which can be accurately and efficiently dispensed through automatic feed and control systems.

#### **High Foaming**

**EVER-KLEEN 9243** provides a copious amount of foam to aid in soil penetration during cleaning. High foam levels promote cleaning solution contact in upper portions of conveyors and vessels.

#### **Free Rinsing**

Chelants and wetting agents in **EVER-KLEEN 9243** are carefully selected to provide excellent rinsing ability and inhibit the formation of calcium carbonate (CaCO<sub>3</sub>) precipitate in the rinse cycle.

#### **Authorization**

**EVER-KLEEN 9243** is acceptable as a general cleaning agent on all surfaces, or for use with steam or mechanical cleaning devices in all departments of official establishments operating under the federal meat, poultry, shell egg grading, and egg products inspection programs. After use, a potable water rinse is required. **EVER-KLEEN 9243** is available in 5 gallon plastic pails, 55 gallon drums, and in bulk.

### SAFETY AND HANDLING

Wear goggles and rubber gloves when handling this product. Keep out of reach of children. Do not add strong oxidizing agents such as chlorine to concentrate.

### GENERAL DIRECTIONS

**EVER-KLEEN 9243** can be applied by manual methods as in general housekeeping operations. Dilute 1 part **EVER-KLEEN 9243** with 10 to 20 parts water at up to 120°F. In high pressure spray cleaning of COP systems, a dilution of 1 part **EVER-KLEEN 9243** with 50 to 100 parts water at 140°F to 160°F, is recommended. When used in steam cleaning equipment, use 1:10 to 1:20 ratios. In power floor scrubbers, use a ratio from 1:10 to 1:80 depending on the soil load to be removed. For foam generating, use **EVER-KLEEN 9243** at 2 to 4 quarts per gallon of water at 120°F to 160°F. Brush, or spray the solution. Wash wall from bottom to top to avoid streaks on paint. Rinse solution from surface after application.
